



- 1 X UKCC2 (+CDWs)
- 3x UKCC1s

   UKCC1 coaches at the club,

   return to lend a hand



#### **ECB Clubmark**

- Bradford on Avon has registered for ECB Clubmark and now we're pulling together the various item of evidence for accreditation. We're planning to have our evidence file assessed in April/May 2013 and site visit during May/June 2013
- ECB Clubmark is assessed against the four themes of :
  - Duty of Care and Safeguarding Children ensuring that all children who play cricket have a safe, positive and fun experience, whatever their level of involvement
  - 2. The Cricket Programme should assist young players to realise their potential through the combination of coaching, training and competition
  - 3. Knowing Your Club and its Community One Game widens the appeal of cricket to ensure as many people as possible are welcomed into the game at all levels regardless of age, race, ability, gender, ethnic origin, nationality, colour, parental or marital status, religious belief, class or social background, sexual preference or political belief
  - **4. Club Management** Clubs that are well managed tend to be successful. They have well ordered finances, and keep volunteers and members well-informed with good communication

## Competitions


- Under 11s will play in the 8-a-side Bath & District Youth League. Their games are usually played on Monday evenings starting at 6pm
- Under 9s will play in Kwik Cricket Tournaments organised by Clubs under the supervision of the Wiltshire Youth Cricket League. Tournaments are on Sunday mornings
- The club will review the amount of matches available once coaching begins.
   Depending upon the level of interest we receive, we may arrange further friendly matches
- Parents will be expected to help with travelling to away matches

## Volunteering

- If you want to help, there's a number of ways you can get involved. We need:
  - Team managers to help organise each team on match days
  - Team scorers
  - Umpires
  - Coaching assistants to help oversee small-sided activities & games on practice nights
- For all the above roles, the coaches will provide in-house introductory training sessions to get you started
- If you want to get involved further, the Club would be willing to help arrange formal training through the ECB
- For all activity, the club expects to have a minimum of one ECB qualified coach at training sessions and at matches for cricket, safety & insurance purposes

## **Long Terms Aspirations**

- Bradford on Avon Cricket Club would like to grow the Youth Section as follows:
  - Provide coaching for u13s from 2014
  - Provide coaching for u15s from 2016
  - If possible, provide 'u13s girls coaching' from 2015
  - If possible, provide 'u15s girls coaching' from 2017
